

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DIGITAL STUDENT QUESTIONNAIRE how I use it in my classroom!

I created this student questionnaire for my own students, and I'm so excited to share it with you! Here's how I use it in my classroom:

- Each year, I give the survey to each of my classes. I tell them that they don't have to answer every question, but aim for at least 5 so 1 have something to work with.
- Then, I create questions on a Blooket or Kahoot game, like "Which student likes pepperoni on their pizza?' or 'What is Megan's favorite animal?'. I try to make sure each student has at least one or two questions about them in the game.
- Lastly, we play! It's perfect to pull up when we have extra time in the class period, as a reward, or before a school break when energy is high! It's also one of my favorite end of the year activities!

Other Uses:

- Create a game based around one student as a fun twist on star of the week!
- Include questions on teachers, instructional aides, student teachers, or other adults in the school to help students get to know the important staff members at school!
